## Assembly of Centuries

Declared war and peace
Elected the magistrates or public officials who oversaw the daily affairs of government

Assembly of Tribes
35 tribes 4 elected 10 officials called tribunes. Could veto any acts they felt were contrary to the public interest

| Consuls | 2 elected for one year terms | Chief executives who ran the <br> government. <br> Also army commanders could veto acts <br> of the other governed with the advice of <br> the Senate |
| Praetors | many throughout the Republic | Served as military commanders and <br> judges. made most of the laws. |
| Censors | many throughout the Republic | Registered people by their wealth - <br> census [like an ancient Roman IRS] |
